Protects the visual amenity of the area by taking care of how the project area looks

Manages waste appropriately	
<b>Traffic</b>	
Manages heavy vehicle transport effectively and sensibly selects truck routes	
Manages traffic from construction and operations appropriately	
<b>Economy</b>	
Employs local people and contracts local businesses	
Manages any impacts to workforce available to other small businesses in the area	
Impacts on available housing and accommodation in the local area	
Provides targeted opportunities for Indigenous community members	
<b>Social</b>	
Manages activities and infrastructure so that employees and the community are safe	
Works with the community to improve local infrastructure and services and does not put pressure on these facilities	
Project contractors and employees behave appropriately in the local area	
Engages regularly with community members and provides opportunities for community members to participate in and provide feedback regarding the project
